

PAGERS, CELLULAR PHONES, & GUM CHEWING

1. All pagers, cellular phones, or any other similar devices must be turned off and out of sight during classroom hours. These devices interrupt class time and are disturbing to fellow students and teachers. If any of the above listed devices are left ON and interrupt class time, the following rules apply:

- a. You must hand over the pager, phone, etc. to any school personnel that ask for it.
- b. We realize that these devices are expensive, and we will be glad to return it, BUT your parents are the only people allowed to pick it up. They will be notified that you have broken a school rule and that they may pick it up in the Front Office.

2. Chewing gum is not permitted at The Education Center. Our policy is that you will receive a warning the first time. Any infraction after that will result in (in-house) Community Service of 8 hours.

TELEPHONE

The telephone in the front office is not a public telephone. Never ask to leave class to make a phone call. Students may use the phone in an emergency situation and must have a telephone pass from the teacher. Students may not receive messages in the office; tell your friends not to call you or ask to see you at school.
