

DRESS AND APPEARANCE

Due to the fact that The Education Center doesn't require students to wear uniforms, all of you must respect and adhere to the policies below.

It is assumed that young ladies and gentlemen know through parental instruction what is acceptable in regard to dress wear. The usual dress at The Education Center is casual but neat. **All students are expected to wear nice blue jeans or khaki pants and knit or cotton shirts with collars.** *The school reserves the right to determine what is neat and well groomed.*

To further emphasize the policies of dress and appearance please adhere to the following:

- ❑ Shoes must be worn at all times. No rubber flip-flops.
- ❑ Mini-skirts and shorts are NOT allowed.
- ❑ Jeans and pants must be neat with no holes.
- ❑ Low cut (below the waist) jeans and pants are not allowed for males and females.
- ❑ Hats, bandanas, handkerchiefs and caps are NOT allowed on campus (inside and out), and will be taken away and not returned.
- ❑ Distracting jewelry is NOT allowed by males or females. (multiple earrings, chains, nose rings, etc.)
- ❑ Imprinted t-shirts are not allowed.
- ❑ LADIES: Off-the-shoulder, one-shoulder strapped shirts, halter-tops, tube-tops, spaghetti-strap-tops, are not allowed. Shirts must not be excessively low-cut in the front or back and MUST cover your stomach.
